Petra Olea McGeary, RIP 1922 - 2019

We are sorry to report the passing of Petra McGeary. Petra was a long and faithful member of Sons of Norway and of Valhall Lodge. She was a Golden Member, having joined in 1970. Petra's Valhall friends will miss her greatly.

Petra Nelson was born in Canada on March 8, 1922 and grew up in Minneapolis where she married Thomas McGeary in 1944. They lived briefly in Frankfurt, Germany, after the war and then moved to the San Diego area in 1950. They were original occupants for 60 years of a home in La Mesa. Petra delighted in meeting new people and enjoyed being an Avon and Mary Kaye cosmetics representative, and later an associate in a uniform store. An early member of the United Church of Christ in La Mesa, she was active in the Beta Sigma Phi sorority, and a member of Sons of Norway. Petra loved music: she played piano and sang in the San Diego Chapter of the Sweet Adelines. For many years, she was a Wednesday-night regular at Kelly's Piano Bar in Mission Valley. An avid collector of antiques, she loved playing RummiKub. Petra was an adventurous traveler and enjoyed the sociability of going on ocean cruises. She visited Australia, Ecuador, Britain, Norway, Germany, Austria, Spain, Portugal, Thailand, Jordan, the Adriatic Coast, and Mexico, where she went parasailing at the age of seventy.

Petra was preceded in death by her brother Tommy Nelson and her sister Barbara Barney. She is survived by her children Thomas and Brian McGeary and Barbara Best and by her grandchildren Sean, Trevor, and Avery McGeary and Austin Best. She passed away quietly on January 18, 2019, at Tranquility House, La Mesa. At her request, there was no ceremony, and her cremated remains were scattered at sea.

Vesterheim Museum has many seminars. My daughter and I first encountered the practice of forming hair into wall art when we visited a museum in Bastrop TX, so we were fascinated to watch this one hour episode about the craft of weaving hair into watch chains, brooches, necklaces, hair ornaments, even lace edging on clothing, still practiced in Sweden today. A common craft made by women in the Victorian era, it was as common as knitting and embroidery are today. It was also a cottage industry, a chance for women to earn money without leaving home. The video is not a how-to but a look at the history of the craft, featuring fabulous artifacts from the museum.
