Who Lives in the Northlands During The:

Scandinavian Ice Age (20,000 to 5,000 BCE)

Lady of Laussel - Northern France Everything above the tip end of Denmark was covered in Ice. The Reindeer Move North as Ice Melts away the shorelines.

Migrations (5,000 and 2,000 BCE) as more land is uncovered. Reindeer moving North as southern Norway, Sweden, and all of Denmark become more Mediterranean in climate).

Hällstringar / Petroglyphs Begin

Scandinavian Bronze Age (2,000 to 750 BCE)

Migration of Indo-Iranian brings goats, sheep, cows, and metallurgy/mining to Southern Norway and Sweden and all of Denmark.

String Skirts and Sun goddesses

First Contact with Romans (114 BCE)

"Germanic People discovered by the Pagan Romans" Pagan Roman incursion into British Isles

Scandinavian Iron Age (750 BCE to 1066 CE) - migration and technology advances through travel, trade, and sometimes raiding.

"Viking Era" (750 CE to 1066 CE) Norman Conquest and Christianization of Scandinavia.

Black Death 1349 - Norway ruled by Denmark 1380 -1814, Sweden 1905

Scandinavian Christian Era (1000 ACE - 2000 CE)

Indigenous Icelandic Deal to Christianize Politically and allow for Family Practice Heathenry for 1000 years.
